### SECTION 1 — MULTIPLE CHOICE

*Circle the letter of the best answer. (2 points each)*

**1. Before delivering a SL 1 iteration, a UDT must:**

- A. Obtain written approval from C2DAO for each individual course delivery
- B. Complete the UDT pre-course checklist: verify student accounts, test-login from workstations, print materials, and notify C2DAO
- C. Request a C2DAO instructor to co-teach the first block
- D. Submit a revised lesson plan for approval

**2. The SL 1 lesson plan contains a "Check-on-Learning" section for each block. A UDT should:**

A. Skip these questions if the class is running behind schedule B. Save all check-on-learning questions for the end of the day C. Use these questions to verify trainee comprehension before moving to the next block D. Replace the provided questions with their own questions

**3. A performance measure marked as "Critical" in a T&EO means:**

A. It is the most time-consuming performance measure B. Failure on this measure is automatic No-Go regardless of performance on other measures C. Only a Senior Instructor can evaluate this measure D. The trainee gets two attempts on this measure before it counts

**4. You are delivering SL 1. A student applies an incorrect classification marking during the export exercise. You should:**

A. Quietly fix it and move on — classification issues are embarrassing for the student B. Tell the student to review the classification rules during the break C. Note it for the evaluation but do not address it during instruction D. Stop the class, correct the error immediately, and re-brief the classification rules before proceeding

**5. A unit commander asks you to deliver SL 2 to 5 soldiers. You should:**

A. Deliver the SL 2 course using the published materials B. Tell the commander that SL 2 does not exist C. Deliver a condensed version covering only the most important SL 2 blocks D. Explain that SL 2 is beyond UDT scope and coordinate with C2DAO for the next available iteration or MTT visit

**6. After delivering a SL 1 iteration, you must submit a Unit Training Status Report to C2DAO within:**
